IMPLEMENTATION OF LANDSCAPE ECOLOGICAL KNOWLEDGE IN EUROPEAN URBAN PRACTICE

September 20th – 22nd, 2011 in Laufen, Germany

We invite academics, scientists, researchers, students, graduates, and professionals working in landscape and urban ecology, urban planning and related fields to contribute to the 2nd IALE Europe Symposium on the implementation of landscape ecological knowledge in practice.

GENERAL INFORMATION

We welcome contributions to the main topics:

- Challenges, opportunities and problems of implementing landscape ecological knowledge into urban development and urban ecosystem service management
- Transferring scientific knowledge into practical urban planning and decision making
- Appropriate methodological tools for handling landscape ecological questions in urban areas, e. g. management of soil sealing, water supply, urban nature
- Sharing the experience of implementing landscape ecological knowledge with decision makers
- European case studies: best practice and cases from which we can learn
- Case studies from other countries are welcome if they bear reference to Europe

The 2nd IALE Europe Symposium offers the opportunity for scientists to share their experiences regarding the transfer from applied science to practical planning and the possibility to discuss solutions for an improved transfer in the future. As complex problems and new approaches need to be discussed intensively, we want to offer the appropriate framework. We hope to stimulate lively exchange of views by means of paper and poster presentations and kick-off speeches.

Contributions are welcome as:

- Kick-off speech (about 10 minutes) that provides first insight into a topic and fuels the following discussions by throwing up questions. As we want to keep the topics as open as possible, we would ask you to send us your ideas.
- Paper presentation (20 minutes plus 10 minutes discussion)
- Poster presentation

All proposals for contributions received **before April 15**th, **2011** will be considered by the program committee. Please submit your proposals (max. 300 words) via email to <u>annette.voigt@sbg.ac.at</u>. We will answer until Mai 09th, 2011.

Short Paper:

We will prepare a symposium folder with short papers of the accepted contributions to be sent out to all participants in advance. Your short paper should reach us by June 30th, 2011.
